

FORTIFIED Asphalt Shingle Re-Roof Requirements

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MATERIAL PHOTOS

- 1 Label on .113, 2 3/8" Ring Shank Nails Box
- 1 Underlayment Label
- 1 Roof Deck Tape Packaging (when appliable)
- 1 Roof Vent Packaging
- 1 Low Slope Roofing Material Packaging
- 1 Backside of Shingle Package/Wind Label

We will also accept invoices showing delivery to site address for material photos.

RE-ROOF PROCESS PHOTOS

4 - Roof Deck Nailing with measuring tape 4'

At least 2 pictures of any low slope portions

- 4 Installed Underlayment
- 4 Roof Deck Tape (when applicable)
- 4 Showing Underlayment Fastener Spacing with Measuring Tape
- 4 Drip Edge Nail Pattern

Drip edge always goes on top of the underlayment

- 4 Installed Starter Strips
- 4 Showing all 4 Elevations of Final Installed Roof Cover
- 1 Showing all Installed Roof Vents
- 1 For Each Gable Showing Removable Cover Installed or Permanently Closed

HIGH WIND Risk Cat. 2. V-Ult 115 mph or lower

- 6" roof deck nail spacing with 2 3/8" 8d Ring Shank nails
 OR 4" roof deck nail spacing with 2 1/2" 8d Common nails
 12d 3" nail required when over decking.
- 12" drip edge nail spacing
- Drip edge always goes on top of the underlayment!!
- 15/32" is the minimum required thickness when replacing a broken or rotted deck boards for IRC2021 & IRC2018 (7/16" for IRC2015 & IRC2012).
- If the minimum allowed 7/16" roof deck thickness isn't present, over-decking is required. Exception: 3/8" roof deck thickness is only allowed with 16" rafter spacing.
- For dimensional lumber T&G and Shiplap are typically ok but straight boards with gaps well over 1/8" will require over-decking.

HURRICANE Risk Cat. 2 V-Uly 116 mph or greater

- 4" roof deck nail spacing 2 3/8" Ring shank nails
 - 12d 3" Ring Shank required when over decking
- 4" drip edge nail spacing
- Drip edge always goes on top of the underlayment!
- 15/32" is the minimum required thickness when replacing a broken or rotted deck boards for IRC2021 & IRC2018 (7/16" for IRC2015 & IRC2012).
- If the minimum allowed 7/16" roof deck thickness isn't present, over-decking is required. No Exception For Hurricane Region
- For dimensional lumber T&G and Shiplap are typically ok but straight boards with gaps well over 1/8" will require over-decking.
